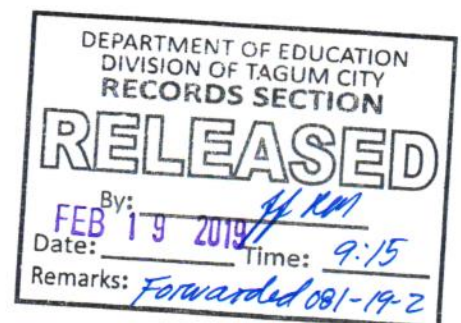

SYNOPSIS NG KABATAAN KONTRA DROGA AT TERORISMO

ANG KABATAAN KONTRA DROGA AT TERORISMO (KKDAT) ay isang programa ng Police Regional Office 11 sa ilalim ng pangangasiwa ng ating butihing Regional Director PCSUPT Marcelo C. Morales, at pinagsamang pwersa ng Regional Mobile Force Battalion 11. Ito ay may layuning itatag ang grupo ng mga kabataan at estudyante upang himukin at pagtibayin ang kanilang kakayahang sugpuin ang problema sa droga at terorismo ng ating bansa.

Sa katunayan, ang KKDAT ay unang inilunsad sa lungsod ng Heneral Santos kung saan tatlong-libong kabataan ang aktibong nakilahok at dinaluhan ng ating Pambansang Kamao, Senador Manny Pacquiao noong Agosto 10, 2018 sa ilalim parin ng pamumuno ni PCSUPT Marcelo C Morales noong siya ay naglingkod bilang director ng PRO 12. Ito ay isang pagpapatunay na seryoso ang inyong kapulisan sa layuning iligtas ang mga kabataan mula sa problema sa illegal na droga at terorismo hindi lamang sa Davao Region.

Sa kasalukuyan, ang KKDAT ay sinimulang inilunsad dito sa Davao Region. Noong nakaraang Oktobre 10, 2018, nagkaroon ng "Soft Launching" sa Panabo City na dinaluhan ng higit kumulang pitong daang studyante na nagmula sa iba't ibang paaralan ng Davao del Norte. Kasunod nito, ang RMFB 11, kaakibat ang PDEA ay nagbigay ng KKDAT Overview sa mga SK Chairperson at mga youth lider ng iba't ibang organisasyon ng Panabo City noong Nobyembre 7 patungkol sa masamang epekto ng terorismo at ang illegal na droga.

Tunay nga na ang problema sa droga at terorismo ay isang malaking hadlang sa kaunlaran ng ating bansa at isang malaking dagok sa kinabukasan ng mga kabataan. Bilang sagot sa mga suliraning ito, ang programang KKDAT ay binuo at ito ay sama-samang lalakuhan ng iba't ibang ahensya ng gobyerno tulad ng Regional Police Drug Enforcement Unit, Youth Affairs and Development Office, Sangguniang Kabataan, Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency, Department of Social Welfare and Development, Department of Education, at Local Government Units.

Sa ganitong pamamaraan, ang kabataan ay magiging mabuting lider, halimbawa at impluwensya sa kanyang kapwa kaibigan at kabataan at sama-sama nilang pagtutulungan ang ugnayan sa komunidad at paaralan.

Ang programang ito ay hindi magiging matagumpay kung wala ang suporta ng iba't ibang sektor ng ating lipunan. Kaya, hinihiling ko po ang inyong patuloy na suporta sa lahat ng programa ng kapulisan at ng ating gobyerno na ang tanging layunin lamang ay makamit ang kapayapaan at kaunlaran ng ating bansa. Kilos kabataan, sapagkat IKAW ang pag-asa, kayo ang mga BAGANI, mga Bagong Bayani!
