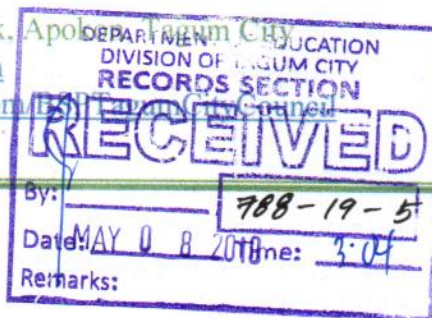



SQUAD DRILL COMPETITION
MECHANICS AND GUIDELINES

1. The participants must be currently registered with the Boy Scouts of the Philippines – Tagum City Council, must be physically fit and possesses a good moral character;
2. Senior Scout and Rover Scout will compete in one category only. They must be in complete SENIOR/ROVER Scout type "A" uniform.
3. Scouts from different outfit/circle or scouting institution can create a squad as long as they are in registered in the same scouting section.
4. The participating squad must be in a group of Senior Scouts or group of Rover Scouts not mix. The squad must have **8 scouts** and **1 drill commander**.
5. Unique Variety of Commands is advised within the given time limit of execution. Additional of 10points to the overall score when English medium is used during Drill Commands.
6. The participating squad shall be given a minimum of **five(5) minute time frame only** for their performance; **one (1) long whistle blast** indicates that the group has already reached the minimum time limit; while **two (2) long whistle blast** indicates that they already reached the **maximum eight (8) minute time frame;**
7. One (1) point will be deducted from the group's score if the performance exceeds the eight (8) minutes time frame; Likewise, one (1) point will also be deducted from the group's score if their performance does not reach the minimum time frame;
8. The Criteria for Judging are as follows.

Participation	-	15%
Uniform	-	15%
Uniqueness	-	20%
Execution	-	30%
Smartness	-	20%
TOTAL	<hr style="width: 100%;"/>	100%
9. The decision of the Judges is **Final and Irrevocable**.

QUIZ BEE
MECHANICS AND GUIDELINES

1. Scouts shall organize their team-contestant with (3) members composed of the following:
 - I. Two (2) Senior/Rover Scouts
 - II. One (1) Boy Scout
2. Each team shall be designated with a number prior to the contest proper.
3. Each question will have this sequence:
 - i. The quiz master will state the question twice.
 - ii. A thirty second timer will start after the quiz master says "go".
4. Each team will write one answer on the provided paper.
5. A whistle will be blown at the end of the timer, and the quiz master will say "time is up."
6. Each quizzier should stop writing on their boards at the point. Failure to do so will invalidate the team's answer for that question.
7. The quiz Master shall dictate to when the quizzers shall raise their answer and keep them raised until the quiz master allows them to lower it. Failure to do so will also invalidate the team's answer for that question.
8. The quiz master will announce the correct answer for that question.
9. Assigned proctors will then check each team's answer board to determine if the answer is correct. The proctor will raise a colored flag to indicate if the answer is:

Blue-correct
Red-wrong (X)
10. The quiz master will perform a roll call of each team and will say if the team's answer is correct or wrong. The points the team and will be then listed onto the score board.
11. After the team is called, s/he will be allowed lower their answer paper and they can prepare for the next question. The proctors will also be allowed to lower their flags during this time.
12. The team with the highest score wins the Quiz Bee.
13. Failure to follow the set mechanics shall mean disqualification of the cluster's entry.
14. All entries shall be judged by a Board and the decision shall be final and non-acceptable.
15. Range of Questionnaires: Scouting History, Scouting Ideals, Fundamentals of Scouting and Advancement.
