SUBJECT : Computer-Based English Proficiency Test (EPT) for Teacher-Applicants of Tagum City Division

DATE : July 8, 2020

The COVID-19 pandemic has heavily affected the various sectors within the country, including the conduct of English Proficiency Test (EPT) in this division set last March 2020. As a response, this office opted for an online examination called Computer-Based Testing to be conducted by DepEd Central Office through the Bureau of Education Assessment (BEA)-Education Assessment Division (EAD). Anent thereto, the Division of Tagum City, identified as Pilot Division in Region XI for Mindanao of the Computer-Based Testing - EPT for Teacher-Applicants, is set on **July 15 - 17, 2020** at the Computer Laboratories in Tagum National High School, Mangga, Visayan Village and Tagum National Trade School, Apokon, Tagum City.

A maximum of 20 examinees are allowed to take the EPT inside the Computer Laboratories by schedule/session in order to implement social distancing (List will be in a separate Memo, also to be posted in DepEd FB Page, GCs, etc.) before July 15, 2020. Precautionary measures such as temperature check, wearing of masks, sanitizing/foot bath must be observed by the examinees and testing staff adopting EO 112: Omnibus Guidelines of the World Health Organization (WHO) Implementation of Community Quarantine guidelines on holding work-related events.
