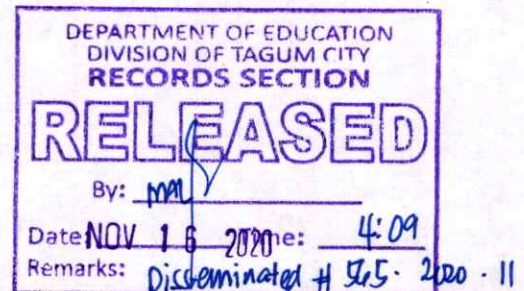

The softcopy of the streamer layout will be sent through email.

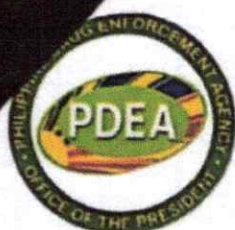
